### **MERGER**

By now hopefully you are all aware that the Practices of Strathmore Surgery and The Calderwood Practice have merged together as of 1st June 2015. The name of the new Practice is "Strathcalder Practice" and the new practice telephone number is 01355 227220.

It was necessary to merge the two smaller practices of Strathmore Surgery and Calderwood Practice due to increasing strains on GP services. The main factors being reductions in income, increasing practice expenses and difficulties in employing locum doctors to cover sick leave and annual leave due to reductions in the number of locum doctors available. We feel that in the long term a larger Practice will have better GP coverage and a better service available for patients.

Unfortunately in the short term there have been many teething problems particularly with regards to computer systems. We still await a date for merger of the two Practices computer systems. We have been pressing the Health Board to help expedite this change as it is causing disruption both for reception staff, doctors and this is impacting on patients. The Health Board have advised us they have no control over this and it is due to the company who make the computer software. They have a significant waiting list for this procedure. A provisional date of December 2015 has been given for the work to be carried out.

The other big difficulty has been the telephone systems and we have an ongoing dispute with the telephone company regarding this. The Health Board is now involved with this and we are doing our best to quickly and effectively improve the problem.

We thank you all for your patience and cooperation during this period of change, but as mentioned, hope it will be of benefit to you all in the long term.
